

JONATHAN'S PLACE VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Jonathan's Place provides a safe place, loving homes and promising futures for abused and neglected children, teens, and young adults.

We depend on the generosity of volunteers to help bring a smile and a helping hand to our children. While our staff provide exceptional care for each child, volunteers allow each child to get more personal attention.

EMERGENCY SHELTER

Emergency shelter volunteers work directly with the staff caring for the children in the emergency shelter who range in age from 0 - 17. Duties include assisting with meals, doing laundry, reading a book, helping with homework, assisting with night time routines, or playing games. Shelter volunteers may also be invited to attend occasional outings with the children.



GIRLS' RESIDENTIAL THERAPEUTIC PROGRAM

This volunteer program is designed to provide consistent, positive relationships between our teen girls and a female adult at least 21 years of age. We require a one year commitment with a minimum of 2 hours of weekly contact. Please note this can be a very challenging environment due to the abuse these girls have endured.



ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANCE

We are in need of volunteer receptionists to answer phone calls, greet guests, accept donations and assist with occasional office work. Our social workers are also in need of volunteers to help with filing, copying, making packets, and other administrative tasks. The hours are flexible, but will need to be during regular office hours.



SAFE PLACE

Safe Place volunteers are needed to assist with community outreach and education surrounding the Safe Place Program. Join the team to help educate youth on staying safe and how to find a safe place when they need help!



MEAL DELIVERY

Interested in volunteering but can't make the time commitment? Consider donating and delivering meals for the kids. All food must come from a restaurant, a store or a commercial kitchen. This opportunity is flexible and delivery times can be scheduled at your convenience.
