

Full Time Professional Foster Parents Needed

Jonathan's Place is accepting applications for full-time, salaried, Professional Foster Parents for the RESET (Restoring and Educating Survivors to Empowerment and Transformation) Long Term Foster Care program. This position provides care to minor victims of sex trafficking in your home. The following is a brief overview of requirements:

Responsibilities / Requirements:

- Responsible for daily care and supervision of survivors.
- Model and teach life skills to clients that will help develop interpersonal relationships and social skills.
- Attend and transport client to all appointments.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Minimum of one year of experience working with children who have experienced trauma.
- Professional Foster Parent must not work outside of the home. This individual is paid to be available, trained, and prepared to support other Professional Foster Parents and advocate for the population even when there is no child in the home.
- If a child is not in the home, the Professional Foster Parents will still maintain the home to standard and will be prepared to receive a young person when needed.
- Prior experience working with survivors of commercial sexual exploitation is preferred.
- Knowledge of child development and behavior management.
- Must have at least one bedroom for each youth placed in the home. Children may not share a room with biological, adopted or child in custody of the Professional Foster Parent.
- No other child in the home may be over the age of 9.
